Liturgical Sign-up Book in Hall. As you all know, we have a book in the hall where people can list their commemorations for the Eternal Light, for the Altar Vigil Candles and for Panachidas. This is the first time I have ever seen this, but I think it is a great idea.

I want to clarify something which has apparently caused some confusion. This pertains mostly to the Panachidas, but also to the other categories. When I am doing the bulletin, I check the book for commemorations so that I can note them in the bulletin. If there is no commemoration in any category, I put a slash through that line, as having been seen and checked off. That does not mean that there cannot be a commemoration made there; it just means

that when I checked it, there wasn't any. If anyone comes into the church after I have checked the list (e.g., on Sunday morning before Liturgy), they are still welcome to add commemorations; those commemorations just will not be noted in the bulletin.

If you would like to have a Panachida on a day that has none, just let me know (send a note up with Frank or John or one of the other ushers). Days on which no Panachidas are permitted (Christmas, Easter, etc.) I will clearly mark in the book as "No Panachida today." If you have any questions about this, just ask.
