*THE APOSTLES' FAST* ends on Thursday, July 11, the day before the Feast of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul on July 12 (whence comes the name)..

This fast is the least strict of the four fasting periods of the year. Traditional rules call for Strict Fast on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The diocesan

rules require merely the usual Wednesday and Friday fast. All are welcome to do more than the minimum.

*FEAST OF THE BIRTH OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST* is today. We will bless the bread, wheat, wine and oil at the end of the Divine Liturgy.

*FEAST OF THE HOLY APOSTLES PETER AND PAUL:* Friday, July 12. Divine Liturgy is at 9 AM.
