**BUS TRIP to "TRYZUB" 22nd ANNUAL UKRAINIAN FOLK FESTIVAL**

North Anthracite Council of the League of Ukrainian Catholics is sponsoring a bus trip to the 22nd Annual Ukrainian Folk Festival at the Ukrainian American Sport Center - "Tryzub" - in Horsham, PA on Sunday, August 25, 2013.

The event which begins at 12 noon and ends at 8:00pm will highlight a stage concert of colorful Ukrainian folk dancers as well as musicians from Ukraine and the United States. Ukrainian ethnic foods, standard picnic fare, baked goods, cool refreshments, Ukrainian arts /crafts bazaar and children's fun area will be available.

TO: The Reverend Clergy of the Diocese  
Glory to Jesus Christ!

Dear Fathers:

With the blessing of His Grace, Bishop Gregory, I wish to share with you the following information which is being announced tomorrow at the Cathedral.

After 44 years of service to the Diocese, and 28 years to Christ the Saviour Cathedral, Pani Connie and I are announcing our retirement from active parish ministry. My service to Christ the Saviour Cathedral will conclude with the celebration of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday, October 27. My successor will be announced soon by Bishop Gregory. At the same time, I am relinquishing my responsibilities as Dean of Christ the Saviour Seminary and Dean of the Johnstown Deanery.

You should also be aware that His Grace has requested me to stay on at present as Chancellor, which I have consented to do at his specific request. In addition, because Christ the Saviour Seminary does not have at this time a resident Prefect, I will temporarily be responsible for the operation of the Seminary until a Prefect is assigned.

I am praying that the Lord bless all of you in your continuing ministries to our Diocese, and in doing so, I remain
